Termination of authorisation of

Hypo Public Finance Bank renamed as Depfa Public Finance Bank by **the Central Bank of Ireland**

The **Central Bank of Ireland** has notified the Malta Financial Services Authority that, with effect from 07th November 2016 and at the request of the licence holder it terminated the authorisation of **Depfa Public Finance Bank** (formerly known as **Hypo Public Finance Bank**) and accordingly, the credit institution is currently not authorised by the said Regulatory Authority to provide services as a credit institution. The credit institution is therefore not authorised to passport its services in Malta under the Capital Requirements Directive (Directive 2013/36/EU) with effect from such date.

In view of the aforementioned termination of authorisation by the **Central Bank of Ireland**, the Authority strongly advises against responding to any offer of financial services from **Depfa Public Finance Bank** (formerly known as **Hypo Public Finance Bank**).
